

VI Polish Match Play Junior Championships 23-25.05.2025, Kraków Valley G&CC

1. Eligible to play in the tournament

- a. Players according to pt. of the General Terms and Conditions Championship Tournament of PGU 2025.
- b. Players with HCP of 18.0 or lower and female players with HCP 20,0 or lower.
- c. Players in the age category: Junior and Younger Junior.

2. Qualifications and registrations of players for the tournament

- a. The tournament is open to 40 male juniors and 20 female juniors, including players qualified with "wildcards". The Tournament Committee has the right to change the number of players in the tournament.
- b. Applications are accepted on the <https://polski.golf/> website until **15th May 2025**.
- c. Qualification for the tournament will be according to the HCP INDEX. The PGU Board reserves the right to award 3 "wildcards" to the tournament.
- d. The list of qualified for the tournament will be published on **16th May 2025**.

3. Tournament Fees and Cancellations

- a. The registration fee is **PLN 330** and shall be paid only through the electronic payment system electronic payment system.
- b. The rules of resignation from participation in the tournament and the rules of return of entry fees according to point 10 and 11 of the General Terms and Conditions Championship Tournament of PGU 2025.

4. Tournament tees

- a. Course length for male juniors: white tees - including changes in length allowed by the WHS Handicap Rules.
- b. Course length for female juniors:
 - **blue tees** – (applies to stroke play section and match play section for players classified above 8th place after stroke play) - including changes in length allowed by the WHS Handicap Rules;
 - **yellow tees** – (only applies to the match play section and female players from places 1-8 after the stroke play section) - including changes in length allowed by the WHS Handicap Rules.

5. Tournament form

- a. **May 23** – one round of gross stroke play played over 18 holes. Based on the results obtained, the competitors will be divided into the following groups:
 - Male juniors: 1-8; the remaining players will be divided into 4-persons groups
 - Female juniors: 1-8; the remaining players will be divided into 4-person groups.
- b. In the event of a tie, the standings will be determined as follows:
 - better gross stroke play result of the last round;
 - better hole score: 10-18; 13-18; 16-18; 18 hole;

- in the event of a tie, the value of the higher HCP will determine the higher position.
- c. **May 24 in the morning** – 1st round – gross match play according to the table in Appendix 1.
- d. **May 24 in the afternoon** – 2nd round – gross match play according to the table in Appendix 1.
- e. **May 25 in the morning** – third round – gross match play according to the table in Appendix 1.
- f. **May 25 in the afternoon** – fourth round – gross match play according to the table in Appendix 1 to these regulations.
- g. The matches in the match play format will be played in the gross system without considering HCP until one of the players wins. If after playing 18 holes the match is not settled, the players shall continue to play on the holes indicated by the Tournament Committee - from the next hole until the match is settled. At the end of the match, the players are not allowed to continue the game and must leave the course or else they will be disqualified.
- h. The result of the completed match must be submitted to the Tournament Committee by the winner of the match immediately after its completion, under pain of disqualification.

6. Concession of the match

- a. The player who concedes the match or withdraw from tournament must give written information of this fact directly to the Tournament Committee or by e-mail to turnieje@polski.golf on the following dates:
 - Morning match – on the eve of the match until 19:00.
 - Afternoon match – within half an hour of the end of the morning match.
- b. A player who concedes or withdrawing from the tournament shall be subject to disqualification.
- c. Against a Player who fails to comply with the obligation specified in paragraph 6 a. Tournament Director shall apply to the Disciplinary and Regulatory Commission of the PZG for punishment under the disciplinary action for unsportsmanlike conduct, immediately after the tournament.

7. Tournament Winners

Winners of the Polish Match Play Junior Championship tournament receive the following titles:

- a. Male Junior:
 - 1st place – Polish Match Play Champion
 - 2nd place – Polish Match Play Vice Champion
 - 3rd place
- b. Female Junior:
 - 1st place – Polish Match Play Champion
 - 2nd place – Polish Match Play Vice Champion
 - 3rd place.
